



**Proceedings of the meeting of “Monitoring Cell on Ragging at the University Level” held on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 at 3.00 PM in the Committee Room of Administrative Block, CSKHPKV, Palampur.**

The meeting of the ‘Monitoring Cell on Ragging at the University Level’ was held under the Chairmanship of Prof. Ashok Kumar Sarial, Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor, CSKHPKV on 25.09.2018 at 3.00 PM in the Committee Room of Administrative Block. The following were present:

The Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor welcomed the members of the Monitoring Cell on Ragging. He informed that in pursuance of the judgment of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India dated 8.5.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, and further letter No. Agr.B(15)-6/2005-Loose dated 06.06.2009 of the Secretary (Agr.) to Government of Himachal Pradesh, the Monitoring Cell on Ragging at the University Level has been constituted. It is a standing Committee constituted to monitor the functioning of Anti Ragging Squads, Anti-Ragging Committees constituted at various levels in the University to eliminate the menace of ragging in the University Campus.

The Chairman informed the Members of the Monitoring Cell that the Academic Year 2018-19 has started peacefully and stated that ragging is a criminal offence and monitoring mechanism must be effective. He expected from the Members of the Monitoring Cell to ensure that all the Anti-Ragging Committees and Squads will keep proper check on the activities of students to nip the evil of ragging in the bud. He asked the members of the Committee to devise anti-ragging mechanism by way of making the students well aware of consequences of the menace of ragging.

The students be kept busy in Academic, Cultural and Sports activities. The Chairman called upon the members to conduct surprise inspection of hostels, reading rooms, canteen, Common Rooms and other places in the Campus vulnerable of ragging in order to continue keeping the Campus ragging free. Thereafter, the Chairman discussed the important points pertaining to measures taken and could be taken by the various committees and squads constituted to keep the Campus ragging free.


- The Students Welfare Officer apprised the members of various actions taken by him and the Wardens of the Hostels for keeping the hostels ragging free. He said that he has cautioned all the Wardens to be careful in watching the activities of the students. He further stated that he himself is conducting surprise checking of hostels. The Students Welfare Officer informed that

resident scholars are being kept busy in the Hostels by involving them in academic, cultural and sports activities. The Chairman applauded the initiatives taken by some of the Wardens for organising Fresher's day in the hostels and advised that other hostel wardens may also initiate such actions for creating cordial and friendly atmosphere in the hostels. He said that a separate page with regard to anti-ragging has been uploaded at the University website in which contact Numbers of important functionaries of the University have been given and message has been written with regard to evil of ragging and its consequences.

- The Dean, Postgraduate studies apprised the Cell that all the postgraduate students have submitted undertaking and Anti-Ragging Committee at Postgraduate level has been constituted for keeping strict vigil on the activities of the Postgraduate students.
- The Dean, College of Agriculture informed that he has taken remedial measure and constituted Anti-Ragging committees at college level to make the College ragging free and stated that he is personally interacting with first year students regularly. The Chairman advised the Deans of all other Colleges to interact with students personally from time to time. He said that no case of ragging has been reported from the College of Agriculture.
- Dean, DGCN COVAS informed that the old and fresh students have been sensitized about the evil of ragging and its consequences and further informed that various anti-ragging committees have been constituted to keep strict watch on the activities of the students. He further informed the Members that two teachers keep vigil of the sensitive places like hostels, Dairy farm etc. in the college during odd hours daily. Posters have been displayed in the college Campus to educate the students and to refrain from indulging in the evil of ragging. He further informed that in Monal Hostel cleanliness competition has been organised in order to create a sense of cleanliness and friendliness. The Chairman advised all other Hostel Wardens to organise Hostel cleanliness competition in their hostels also.
- Warden Shivalik Hostel informed that interaction meeting was conducted to create friendly atmosphere among old and fresh Postgraduate students. The Chairman also advised the Wardens to persuade the students to start Yoga classes in order to keep them physically and mentally fit and at the same time they will remain busy.
- Some of the members suggested that CCTV Cameras need to be kept in working order 24x7. Hostellers be involved to keep the hostel surrounding neat and clean. The Chairman decided that on the eve of Gandhi Jayanti NCC and NSS students of the University be deployed for celebrating **Swachhta Abhiyan** in the University Campus. So, it has been decided to fix 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 (Saturday) for Swachhta Abhiyan. Accordingly, the NCC Officer and NSS Officers of the Colleges shall be directed to do cleanliness and remove wild plants surrounding the respective colleges and PG students be involved for cleanliness of surrounding PG House building. It has also been decided that all the Heads will spare one labourer and pool it under the Estate Officer of the University on 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 for removing weeds surrounding Library, Admn. Block other places in the University.

- The Security Supervisor of the University was directed to take extra care to stop the entry of Outsiders at the Main University Gate and other entry Gates. The outsiders be refrained from playing in the University play ground. The ground and Khel Parisar be made outsiders free. The Vice-Chancellor directed the Security Supervisor to ensure surprise checking at important places in the University Campus from security point of view and also decided that service of a person is to be provided through outsource at the main Gate for assisting the Security Guard at the Main Gate of the University in order to keep an eye on the movement of outside vehicles and outsiders. The Security Supervisor was advised to keep the barrier on the Main Gate down after the University office hours and also to keep record of all unknown entering the University through vehicles or even commuters.
- The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
